Please provide at least 3 possible dates, the time and location of the celebration(s) and an estimate of the number of candidates — all of the above are required to schedule a Confirmation date. We encourage you to choose a date(s) before Holy Week and Easter (April 9, 2017). If your candidate numbers are 20 or less, please give serious consideration to joining with a neighbouring parish.

NEW LEADER FOR COMPANIONS OF THE CROSS: The Companions of the Cross, An Ottawa based Community of Catholic priests, have elected Fr. Allan MacDonald CC as the new General Superior of the Community. The vote happened at the end of their General Assembly, which convened in Ogdensburg, New York, Aug. 30 – Sept. 2. Fr. Allan MacDonald CC will lead the Companions of the Cross Community for 6 years. The Companions of the Cross were founded by Fr. Bob Bedard CC in Ottawa, in 1984. They serve in Ottawa, Toronto, Halifax, Detroit, and Houston.
